PUBLIC CALL (EDITAL) #011/2023

Number of vacancies and areas of knowledge:

1) 1 (one) on Industrial Engineering; with emphasis on:

Economic Engineering

Areas of knowledge to be contemplated:

- economic engineering

- analysis of production costs

- techno-financial analysis of projects

Requirements:

I – any Doctoral Degree obtained for at least 2 (two) years;

II – Physical and mental health for the job;

III - Other documents required (UFABC will intermediate visa process for foreigners)

Remuneration and term of employment:

R\$ 9,916.18 monthly per 40 weekly hours of work for one year, annually extensible up to 4 (four) years for foreigners

Required documents and application:

I – any Doctoral Degree

II – Curriculum vitae or generated on http://lattes.cnpg.br/

III – Curriculum items supporting documents such as published articles, book chapters, certificates etc. (check curriculum analysis chart on the appendix)

IV - research project and/or work plan, referenced and contextualized to the special program, area of knowledge of option and to the Pedagogical Project of UFABC, with a maximum of twelve (12) pages

Detailed characteristics of the vacancy:

Special Teaching, Research or Outreach program:

The role of the visiting professor should strengthen teaching, extension, and research activities, developed during undergraduate and graduate studies, in the area of Industrial Engineering, sub-area Economic Engineering.

It should be part of groups already established at the institution, expanding the lines of research



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currently served and the institution's interface with society, with a view to expanding the number of students covered by undergraduate and graduate courses and the development of new methodologies applied to the area and sub-area of this special teaching, research, and extension program.

It is also expected that the action in extension actions and the establishment of partnerships with the sector productive and technological development can contribute to the strengthening and dissemination of course.

The Industrial Engineering course maintains the regular offer of specific courses, electives and common in engineering, in addition to offering interdisciplinary baccalaureate subjects. In this way the The visiting professor will contribute to the regular provision of compulsory and free subjects, in addition to contribute to the offer of limited-choice courses and participate in character activities extension workers, facilitating an exchange of knowledge and practices.

The visiting professor will contribute to the teaching, research and extension axes along with the Industrial Engineering, as follows:

I) Teaching:

It will teach subjects from the UFABC Industrial Engineering bachelor's degree course, such as Economic engineering, which is a mandatory discipline for all 8 (eight) engineering firms at UFABC and Economic engineering applied to management systems, which is a mandatory course subject, well like other related ones, according to the course coordination planning.

II) Research:

It will work in subjects from the UFABC graduate programs and will participate in activities of research, in collaboration with groups already established at the University, will implement new lines of Research and will guide or co-guide undergraduate students from the Engineering, scientific initiation and/or graduate studies.

III) Extension:

It will assist the Industrial Engineering course in the creation and implementation of extension projects, aimed at Continuing Education Teachers, sharing their knowledge about teaching with their peers of academic content articulated with practical application in real situations within the area for which one is hired.
